*As of January 1, 2015 our Open Access policy is effective for all new agreements. The foundation is granting a two year transition period for policy compliancy. As of January 1, 2017, all publications will be required to publish on our open access terms.

MAKING THE POLICY COME ALIVE

Immediate Changes

- As of January 1, 2015, a non-negotiable open access clause was added to all grant agreements.
- Creation of a centralized budget to pay open access fees

Gates Foundation

- Ensure compliance with minimal operational burden and overhead.


